Together for Theatre Productions are a brand new musical theatre company based in Knutsford, Cheshire. Our aim is to produce high-quality pieces of theatre, allowing our members to showcase their talents, as well as providing a place for new members to learn new skills in our wonderful hobby.

In January 2021, our Artistic Director Lewis Baron, decided he wanted to produce a charity musical theatre concert in order to raise funds for the Theatre Support Fund+. He teamed up with our now Musical Director, Ben Evans-Clarke, and together, with the help of a 13 strong cast, they were able to produce a Socially-Distanced (due to the event taking place in Stage 3 COVID Restrictions), outdoor concert which was a resounding success, raising £750 for TSF+.

Following this event, the pair decided they wanted to produce further productions, and so Together for Theatre Productions was formed.

We are now affiliated to the National Operatic and Dramatic Association (NODA), and are already looking forward to future productions.

Rehearsals



A huge part of our ethos, is to allow our members to be able to partake in productions which are being produced by other societies, in doing so bringing those societies together in support of one another. We aim to rehearse on an ad-hoc basis, and will aim to not over-burden our members in terms of rehearsal commitment.

A rehearsal schedule will be sent out to all members who are taking part in a production, and this will clearly outline when they are expected to attend. There may be times in between these dates, where we may decide it worthwhile to hold additional, smaller rehearsals, however there will always be a discussion held between those required prior to these being scheduled.

As we approach a production, as with any other society, we will increase the frequency of rehearsals, but these will mainly be to bring everything together which has already been covered.

We rely on our cast members to be able to take the initiative to, in between rehearsals, recap any material which has been covered, make comprehensive notes, and also look over any materials they need to. This method of rehearsing allows us to not over commit our members, and ensure the best quality of production possible.

Membership Fees

As much as we would love to be able to keep this completely free, societies like ours simply cannot operate and produce shows without a financial backing; in order to help us towards this, and also to ensure we can insure you on stage, we do have to charge a membership fee.

We have conducted research into local theatre society memberships, and have decided on a fee of just £15 per year to become a member of TFTP! This fee entitles you to be in our shows, as well as not having to pay an audition fee, which would otherwise be £5.

Memberships run from April to April, and should be paid by the August each year; an AGM will be held in April/May, and from that point, memberships become due for the next year.

Memberships can be paid via BACS, or by visiting our Members Shop which can be found at TFTP.square.site, where you will also be able to purchase any company merchandise, show merchandise, or purchase tickets to any social events we may hold.
